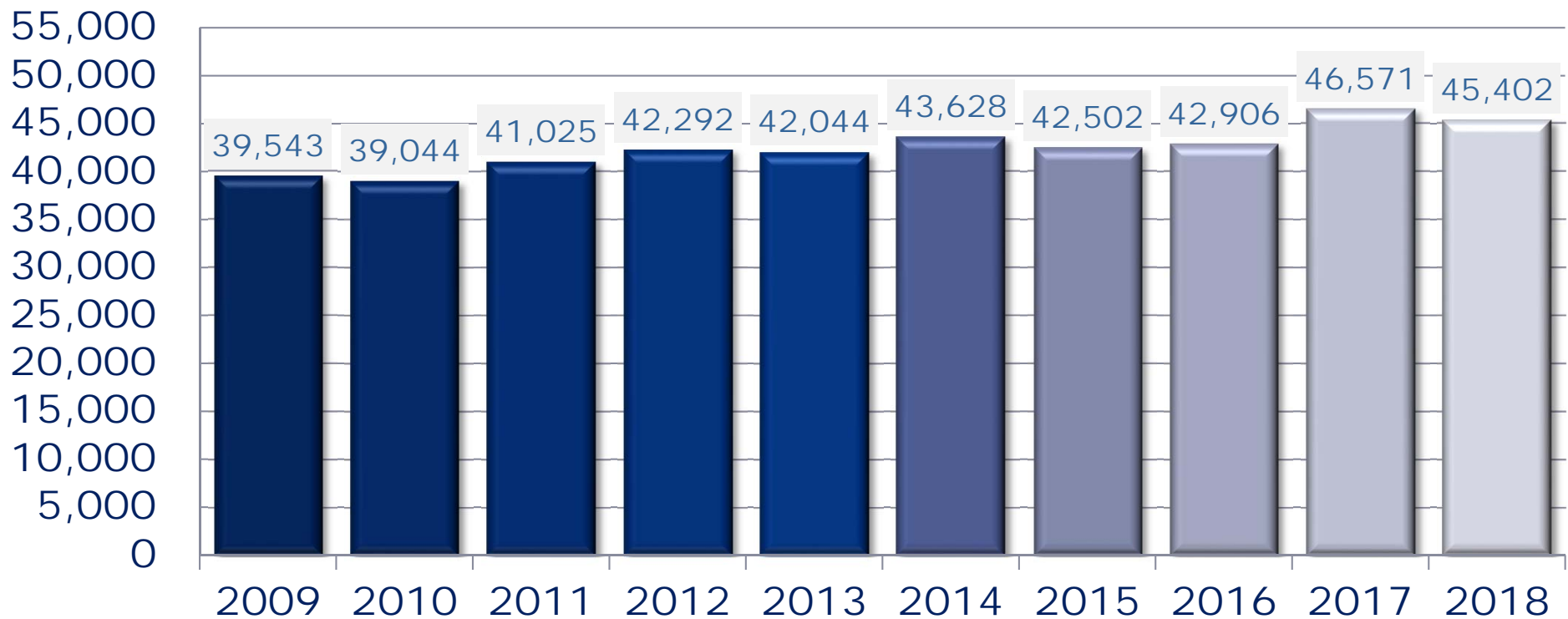


Organizational Chart (2018)

## Calls for Service: 2009 - 2018

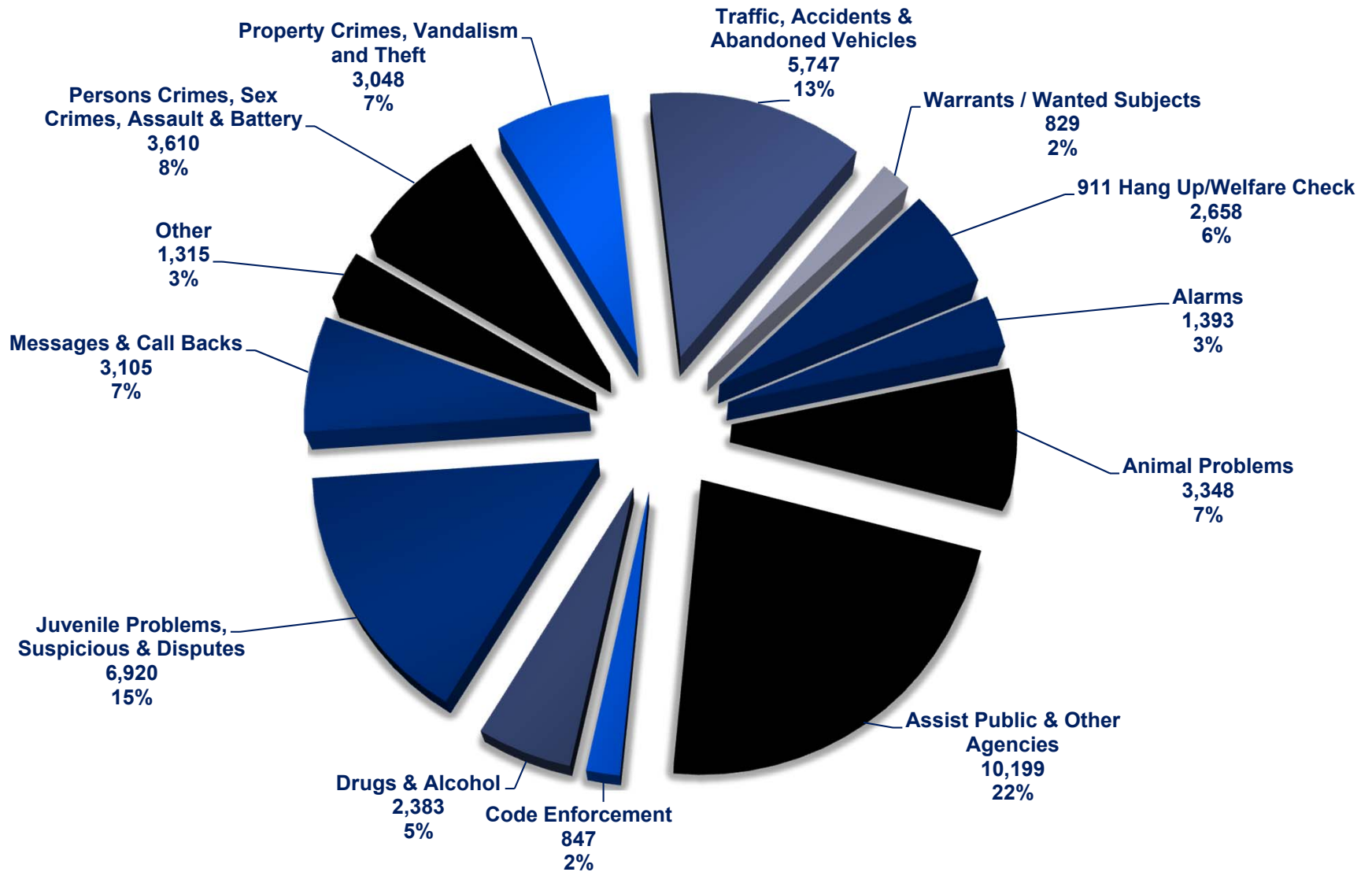


**TOTAL CALLS INCREASED 15% IN PAST TEN YEARS**

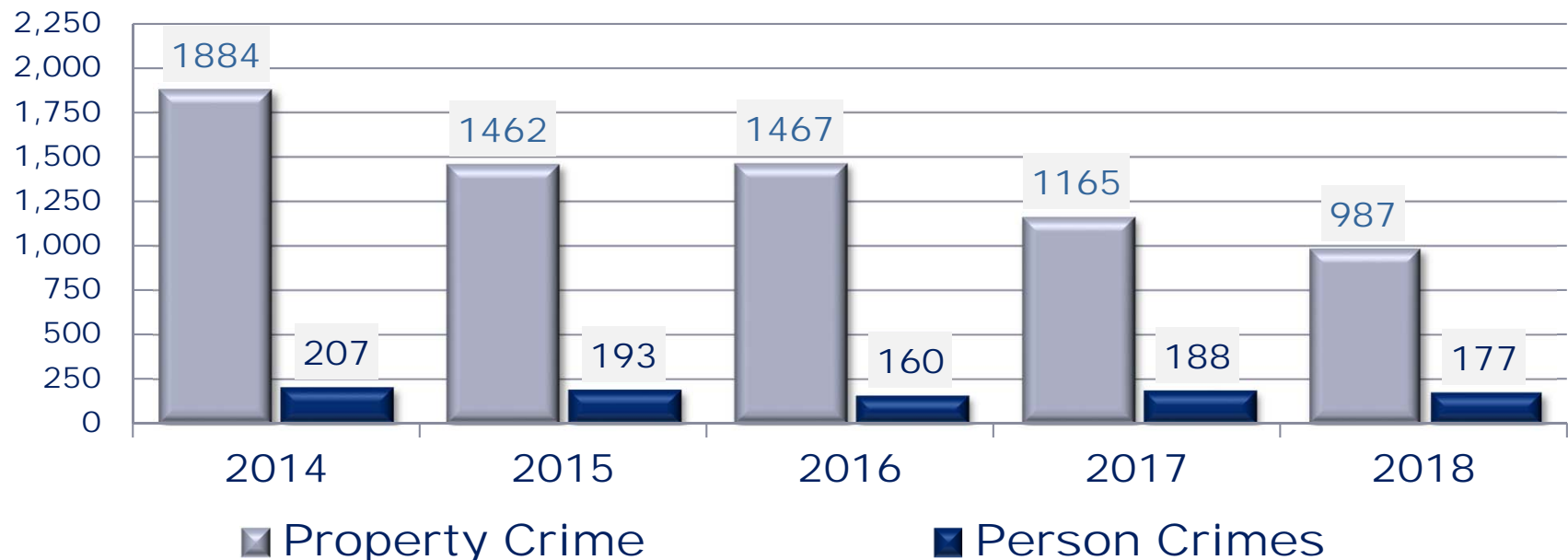

 2014 to 2018 decrease of 47.61%

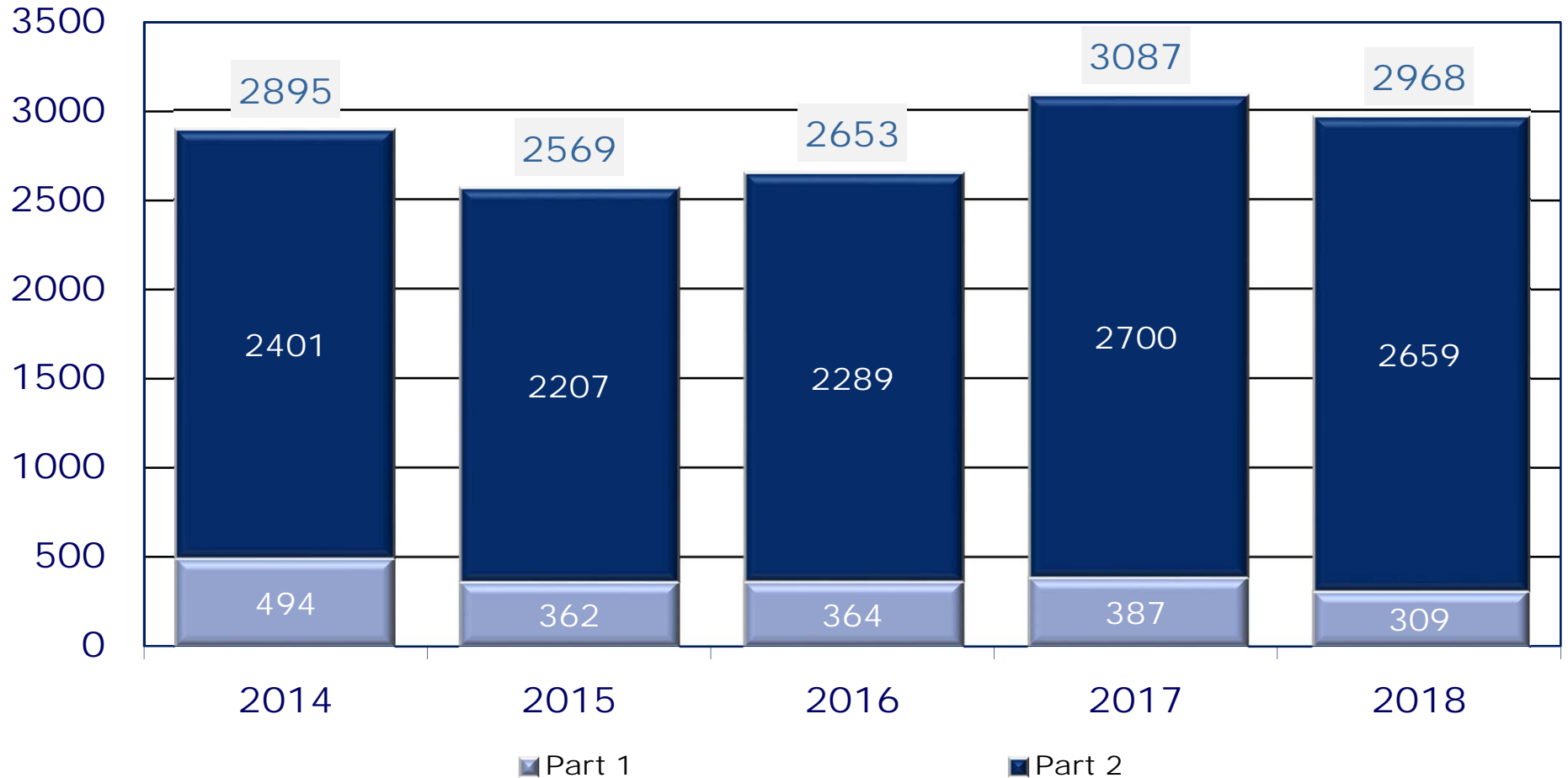
### Person Crimes Comparison to Previous Years:

# Part 1 & 2 Crime Arrests by Year

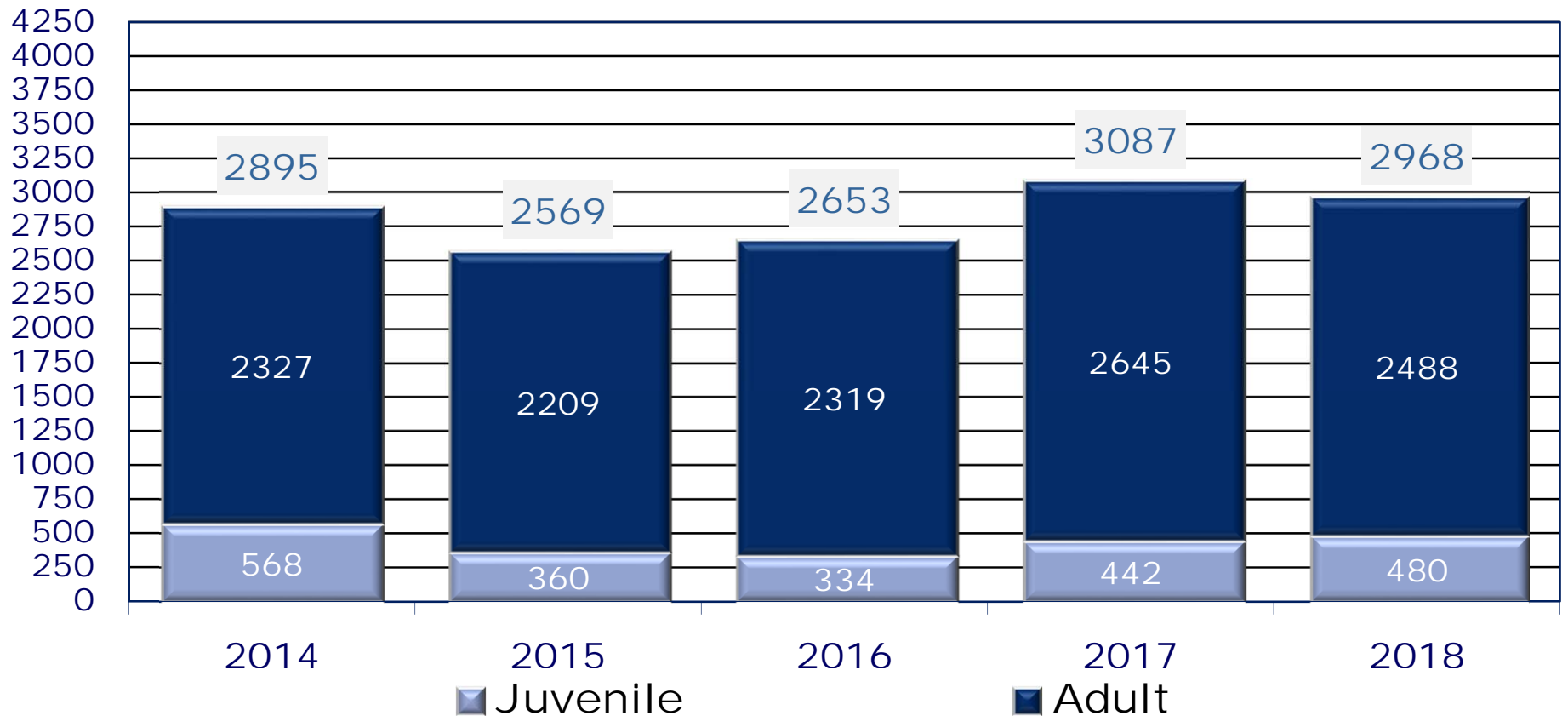

## Adult, Juvenile & Total Arrests



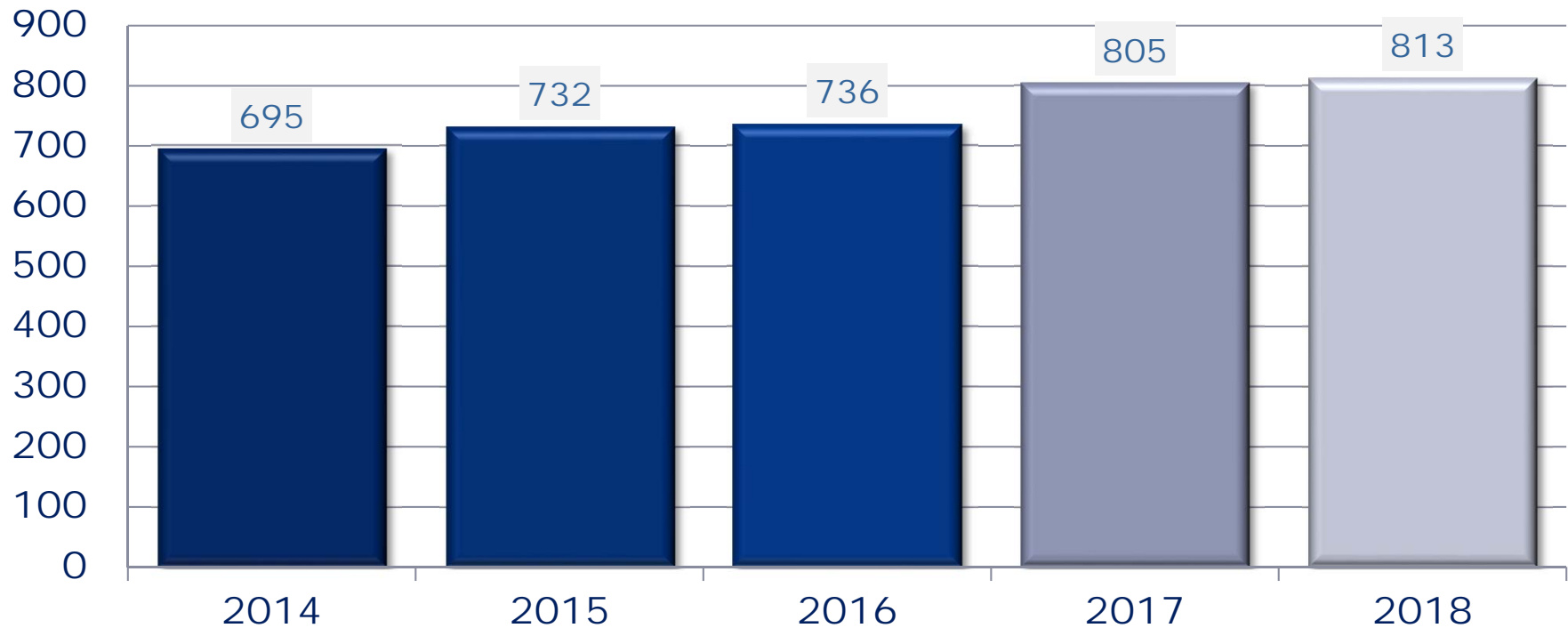
