- We continue to provide two CDAFD firefighter paramedics to the Kootenai County Joint Agency SWAT Team.
- ♦ Continued partnership with North Idaho College in which we sponsor & host the Firefighter-1 & 2 Programs, EMT Program and CPR/First Aid public education classes. The FF program is overseen and instructed by Deputy Chief Bill Deruyter, FF Blaine Porter, FF Greg Thaxton and FF Chris Kieres. The program has turned out approximately 21 students who were hired as professional firefighters in the local area. Numerous others have become professional wildland firefighters throughout the region. The EMT Program & CPR classes are instructed by Engineer Jeff Butcher.
- ♦ CDA firefighters, joined by multiple North Idaho firefighters, made their way up Canfield Mountain in lieu of the LLS Firefighter Stair Climb Fundraiser that was postponed at the Columbia Center in Seattle due to Coronavirus worries. The teamed raised an impressive \$16,733!
- Council approved the construction of our very own boat house, also known as Station #5, located
 at the 3rd Street docks. This is a welcome addition to the Department and will allow us to better
 serve the community.
- Deputy Chief Bill Deruyter helped raise \$750 at the Annual Fitness Charity Bike Fundraiser for the Kootenai County Police & Fire Memorial Foundation.
- Firefighter Chad Matchell and K9 Scout were deployed with WA-TF1 to the Holiday Farm Fire in Oregon to search the rubble for seven days. They searched through the remains of hundreds of houses. Scout performed exceptionally well, despite the fact that the air was harsh with a smokey fog and he was navigating through terrain and obstacles he had never seen or trained on before. Scout and Matchell were proud to be a part of the search effort.
- We hosted two COVID-19 prevention events where we offered free face masks to the community, as well as provided masks to the high schools, local senior center and the City departments. Overall, we handed out around 7,000 masks to the community.
