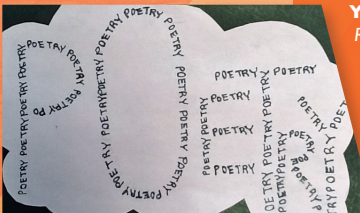


Youth Zentangle
