Sealed Bids will be received by the City Clerk for the City of Coeur d'Alene, 710 Mullan Ave., Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, on or before the 31st day of January, 2018, until the hour of 10:00 AM, local time, for the Landings Well Rehabilitation Project. Bids will be opened in Conference Room 5 in City Hall at 10:00 AM. All interested individuals may attend.


An Idaho Public Works Contractor License is required to bid and complete this work. All bids shall contain Bidder's security in an amount equal to 5% of the total Bid amount, payable to the City of Coeur d'Alene, in the form of: a) Bidder's Bond executed by a surety company qualified to conduct business in the State of Idaho, b) Certified Check, c) Cashier's Check, or d) Cash. Bids are subject to acceptance for 35 days after the bid opening.

The purpose of this project is to remove the pump, inspect the well, and rehab or replace the pump bowls, shafts and worn parts. All bids shall be based on the Bidder's Instructions and Specifications, and the descriptions and additional data sheets provided in the Technical Provisions. Data sheets shall be provided as technical references for materials and equipment to be provided under this bid. Bid packets, related documents, and a more detailed scope of work may be obtained or examined at the offices of the City Clerk.

The City, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat.252, 42 US.
