Aggravated Assaults – 56% Decrease: No domestic related incidents reported. Dispositions: 1 closed by arrest, 2 active and 1 inactive case.


Auto Burglary – 30% Increase: Numerous smash and grab cases with purses taken. The suspects are believed to be part of an organized group that travels through out the U.S. District 83 (North east CDA area) had the most reported incidents for November.

Non Residential Burglary – 20% Increase: Two incidents on Ironwood Drive with forceful entry, no suspects.. Wendy's on Canfield Avenue, was entered by cutting a hole in the roof. CDA City Parks shop was forcefully entered, nothing taken. The remaining two cases have suspects that used to work at the businesses.

Residential Burglary – 150% Increase: Ten incidents reported with three closed by arrest. Two victims reported an unknown suspect inside their residence that fled before law enforcement arrived, four garages/sheds entered and an apartment under construction had tools taken.

Theft – 15% Decrease: 46% of the incidents were shoplifting, 1% were stolen bicycles and the remaining were thefts where the suspect had legal access to or open to the general public.

Vehicle Theft – No Change: Five of the eight vehicles have been recovered, the outstanding incidents include a stolen truck, scooter and motorcycle. One suspect was arrested by Post Falls PD. Three incidents had known suspects that were family/friends. No specific makes/models being stolen. Crimes seem to be more an opportunity than a trend.




Arrest Statistics for November 2016

CDA PD Arrests Custodial vs. Warrant








CDAPD Compstat Crime: Monthly Map for November 2016 (South of Appleyway / Best)



Coeur d'Alene Monthly Comparison – Compstat Crimes










