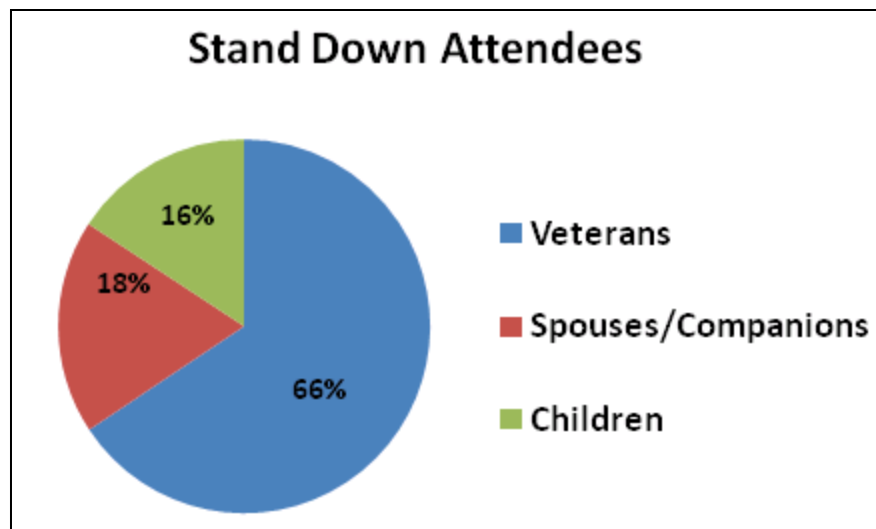

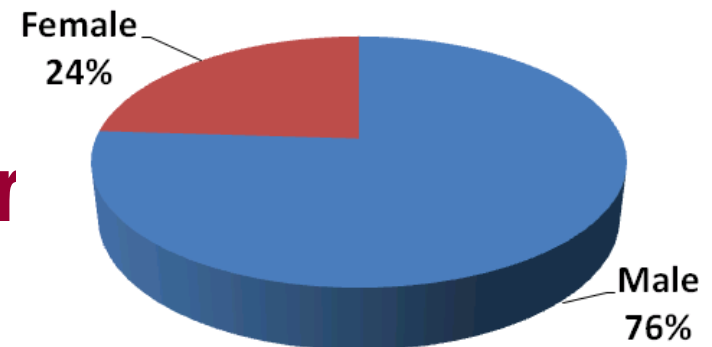


Veteran Ages
