This letter is intended to serve as the City of Coeur d'Alene's response to the request for additional information to the Action Plan for Program Year 2010, pursuant to HUD review letter dated April 1, 2010.

- Table 3A including the annual objective summary is attached hereto.
- A substantial amendment citizen participation process, to clarify the award of community grants, will be conducted within the next 60 days. The Ad Hoc Committee has reviewed grant applications and will make an award recommendation to the City Council on May 24, 2010. Once City Council approval is provided, the substantial amendment process will begin.
- The reference to Disability Action Center was in error, it was intended to reference the local Disability Action Agency. The term "Center" is a historic reference, and the local non-profit currently uses the title "Agency."

In section VI HUD states that "the City has included a nicely detailed color map," yet under the Field Office Director section it states, "The second challenge is the inclusion of a map at a scale that renders it extremely difficult to understand." The City believes that a map demonstrating the geographical distribution of funds within the City is an important tool for the public. It is the City's intent to continue use of the GIS Mapping tool for Action Plan and the CAPER. Therefore, in an effort to improve the map, please provide more details regarding the size of map that would be preferable. We intend to provide the map on our webpage with zoom capabilities.
