- Coming out of winter the midtown lot only needs swale & irrigation done and the city is primed and ready to get this done asap.
- Work between 3rd/4th on Front Ave is ongoing to repair the dip in the street. Fully anticipated 6-7ft fill material with lots of water in the west side of the parking garage. When opening the hole, they found disconnected water pipes. It now seems that they didn't use the right materials the most compacted area was found at about 7ft down which should be the furthest down they need to dig and so it can be rebuilt up from there. A French drain and more dry wells will be placed on the Front Side. A structural engineer will need to be hired to come in to access how much water damage has been done to the rebar in the parking garage. Hopefully this project will be completed within 1 week. *Note None of the material coming out will be going back in!

- The possibility of programming to do some signs downtown with the colors talked about has resurfaced. Chairman to look through and propose locations for vehicular traffic signs.
