Approval of Minutes:

Staff Comments:

Unfortunately, Mr Petersen passed away April 27th, 2024. 2 commissioners will need to be approved at a future meeting for approval by Council to fill commission seats.

The turnaround in McEuen Parking Lot for Thomas George construction drop off will be reduced at the end of April to increase daily parking availability.

Justice building should be completed in June.

Parking Permits will now be fully digital in all lots, no paper permits.

Troy will check with NIC to see if the lots on Hubbard will be able to be used this summer.

Staff would like to ask the commission whether they would like to reduce the meeting schedule even further due to lack of agenda items.

A deeper clean is needed of the parking lot including a deeper power wash, window cleaning and refreshing the garden beds around the garage. Downtown Association will get a list together and submit to Troy.

Parking Lot Revenue:

March was a great month \$71,001. Q2 ended up \$52,191 due to price increases. 112 over last year in permits over last year in March. Although there are less permits, revenue is up due to price increases.

Thomas George parking might decrease in McEuen by the end of April as outdoor construction should be completed.

Commissioner Seat Application:

No Quorum – no formal recommendation was made in regard to Jonathon's appointment to the commission. Mr Jonathan Burns' application will be moved to the next meeting.
