He mentioned that he will look to find opportunities for public notice next season to try to get the word out. John Schwandt wanted to look to have past tree plantings photographs from the 4th grade seedlings for next season.

7.) INSPECTION REQUESTS:

- UF # 24-21: 743 Government way: removal request, the committee recommended removal of deadwood and then continue to monitor the tree, removal denied.
- UF # 24-12: 825 Park Ave: 7 Ponderosa pine tree removal request, the homeowner believed that the trees may have a beetle infestation. The committee found no evidence of beetle infestation. Removal denied.
- UF # 24-16: 501 Honey locust removal request. Tree found to be in good health and condition. Clearance and structural pruning recommended. Treatment with Ethephon to reduce seed pod growth as this was a concern of the homeowner. Removal denied.
